Over the years the Scheme has contributed generously towards essential conservation of the church fabric. The spire has been refurbished, and more recently the windows in the north transept have been restored.

Currently the church has received an "in principle" offer of an English Heritage grant towards repair of the crumbling masonry of the tower. The first step in this project is a detailed survey to assess the size of the problem, and this is under way.

The preservation of this architecturally important church in the attractive and historic village of Ombersley places a large financial burden on our congregation and the local funding bodies who contribute towards its upkeep. We thank all our donors, without whom we could not continue this work.
